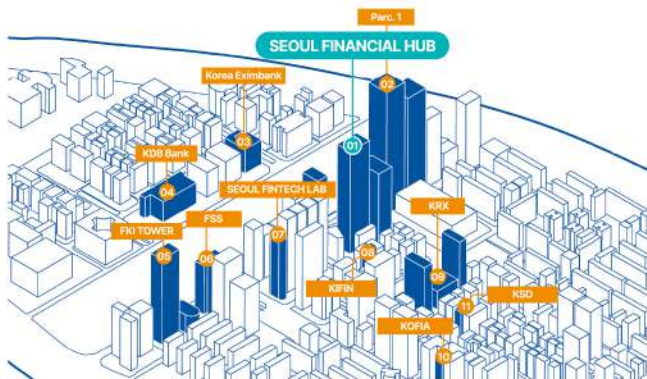


A financial policy in Seoul

What We Offer

Provide office space

- Office space from 21.75 to 91.39 m²

Support for revitalizing business of tenant institutions

- Support up to KRW 5,000,000 in business expenses to tenants per year
- Scope of support
 1. Pre-cost Support for Deal sourcing and due diligence
 - Cost of using professional services accompanying market research and deal sourcing
 2. Investment cost support for Legal, Finance and Accounting
 - Legal service costs incurred at the contract drafting and review stage
 3. Operating cost support for Recruitment and Corporate PR
 - Recruitment platform usage fee for talent recruitment

How to Apply

Qualification

- Foreign financial institutions newly entering or re-entering Korea
- Institutions planning for entry into South Korea in their preparation stage of market advance to or local establishment in Korea

Years of tenancy and usage fee

- Year of tenancy: 2 years (extendable 3 times of 1 year each, up to 5 years based on performance evaluation)
- Usage fee: KRW 30,000 per 1m² per month (VAT excluded)

Exclusions

- Relocation of offices(head office, branch, etc.) of an institution already operating in Korea

Procedures

- Submit required documents through online platform 「Seoul Financial Hub > Apply for Tenancy」
- Required Documents : Application Form, Business plan, etc.
